CREATIVE RESPONSE

Epiphany reminds us of our own mission or calling to make known the story of God's love to those around us.

Cut a large star out of cardboard. At each point of the star list the names of people with whom you would like to share Christ; a mission agency or activity you would like to support; or a place or region where the Gospel needs to be proclaimed. Hang the star above your home altar or meal table as a reminder to pray for these people, mission activities and mission fields.
